

General Instructions for 150-Word Statement:

The 150-word statement will address the specific criteria of each award applied for. Reference letters are not required as part of your application, **please do not solicit references from faculty or employers.**

Rehabilitation Sciences Award (7971) and Janet Louise Berryman Scholarship in Medicine (5613) will only require an application form. No 150-word statement is required.

General Instructions for CV:

CV needs to be in point form, 1-2 pages, and to include the following (and only those) headings: Education; Paid Employment; Professional Involvement and Contributions to the Profession; Community Volunteer Experience; Department Volunteer Experience; Awards and Recognition.

Dos:

- Be selective in what you include and try to highlight the most significant items.
- Include awards and education received before entering the program. Under awards please include the amount of \$ received for each.

Don'ts:

- Please include only items that are relevant to being in a health profession (for e.g. please don't include under employment the work you did as a waiter or a painter).
- Do not include activities that all MOT students are doing like clinic visits, health mentor, IP passport, course work, and participation in Capstone presentations.
- Do not include reference letters as part of the application.
